The petitioner impugns the order dated 31.05.1994 denying him benefit of regularization of his services as Carpenter which he prayed for in terms of the instructions of the State Government appended to the petition as Annexure P1 entitling a Work Charge Employee who has completed five or more years of continuos service as on 31.03.1993 to be regularized in service.

The respondents state that the petitioner does not fulfill this condition in view of the details of the days he has worked which have been reproduced as under:-

88-89	89-90	90-91	91-92	92-93
179	276	270	291	360

This fact has not been denied by the petitioner as he has not filed any counter affidavit. Therefore, the stand of the respondents cannot be termed to be erroneous that the petitioner has not completed five years of service on the appointed date.

The writ petition is, therefore, dismissed.

However, this would not be construed an impediment in the way of the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for regularization in case he

continues to be in service and attracts the terms of the policy Annexure P1 or any other policy which may have come into existence subsequently.
