MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for her release in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 112 dated 11.2.2015 registered under Sections 370, 370A, 372, 373, 342, 343, 109, 120-B, 506 IPC at Police Station Sadar Hisar.

The allegations set out against the petitioner are that she is a part of a group/gang which is engaged in human trafficking by selling orphans or destitute women for immoral purposes.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has neither been named in the FIR nor there are specific allegations against her, to which learned counsel for the respondent states that as many as four of the accused persons are in custody and the petitioner escaped the net because of her false and assumed name. It is contended that this matter requires intense investigation and the petitioner's plea cannot be accepted at the first blush.

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On due consideration of the matter and noticing the aforesaid accusations against the petitioner, I am of the considered opinion that such like matters often require indepth investigation. It will be a matter of deep probe to unravel the number of people involved and their role in such serious offences of human trafficking effecting destitute and helpless women. No ground to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail is made out.

Hence, dismissed.
