Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Rajbir Singh (*Devar* of the complainant) in case FIR No.134 dated 11.03.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 354-B, 354-D, 323, 506 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sadar, Karnal.

As per allegations the family members of the husband Jasbir Singh have inflicted injuries upon the complainant including the petitioner and tried to tore off her clothes. Further allegation is that the co-accused brother Sukhbir Singh tore off the clothes of the complainant while the petitioner made a video clipping of the same on his mobile.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the entire

dispute is regarding a house after the death of their father between the three brothers and a false allegation has been made by the complainant Bhabi.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from Lady HC Meena submits that as per the statement of the mother of the petitioner the said mobile with video clipping is in the custody of the petitioner-Rajbir. He further submits that although the petitioner has joined investigation, however, he has not cooperated by tendering the said video clipping.

Without commenting on the merits of the case keeping in view the serious nature of charges and recovery of mobile with video clipping has to be made, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

Dismissed.
