The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they allegedly apprehend a threat to the same at the hands of private respondent No. 5.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition at the initial stage itself by granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No. 3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, as regards their apprehension and threat perception. Respondent No. 3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, is directed to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and which are warranted strictly in accordance with law.
