The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in the case in which a complaint was made by the Gram Panchayat. The allegations are that the Gram Panchayat was constructing animals skelton dumping ground and had collected 5000 bricks. The allegations against the petitioner are that they had demolished the structure and had given threats.

Heard.

No record has been placed on record that petitioner is in possession or owned the property.

On the last date of hearing petitioner was asked to place on record the lease deed, if any, in their favour from the Gram Panchayat which they had failed to do so.

Considering the allegations, custodial interrogation is necessary. Recovery is also to be effected. No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
