TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take action on the representation dated 03.03.2015 at Annexure P-2 as also for taking adequate measures for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard and the case paper book has been perused.

Insofar as the representation is concerned, the same would reveal that the petitioner had allegedly credited an amount of Rs.20 lacs in the account of private respondent No.5 in relation to some proposed land deal. Grievance raised is that till date, neither the money has been returned nor any deal has fructified.

Clearly, such representation would not call for any directions to be issued by this Court in exercise of its powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. It would be open for the petitioner to pursue and avail of any other remedy that may be available to him in such regard.

As regards the prayer for protection of life and liberty is concerned, the instant petition is completely bereft of any pleadings/averments as regards the threat perception.

No interference is called for and the instant petition is dismissed.
