Learned State counsel on instructions from Head Constable Hardip Singh states that offence under Section 307 IPC has already been deleted. After investigation of the case, Police has prepared untrace report, which is yet to be approved by Competent Authority. Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

In view of aforesaid, prayer would become infructuous in the event of acceptance of untrace report by the Competent Authority. Liberty is given to petitioners that in case untrace report is not accepted by the Court, they may approach this Court again on the basis of compromise.
