RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to investigate the allegations of complaint/ representation.

The allegations have been made in the context of conduct of respondent No.4 in availing benefit of reserved category despite the fact that she belongs to general category. The allegations of forgery and fabricating of signature are the subject matter of representation filed by the petitioner before respondent No.2. At this stage, it will be just and appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide the claim of the petitioner after making inquiry. If some cognizable offence is made out, then respondent No.2 would be obligated to act in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of.
