NAVITA SINGH, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No. 291 dated 25.12.2011, under Sections 323, 341 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 submits that statements of some of the accused persons are not required. The complainant made a statement before SDJM, Nakodar that he had entered into a compromise with accused persons and he has no objection, if the FIR is quashed. Compromise deed signed by the complainant and the accused is also on record.

Report from the SDJM, Nakodar has been received. In his report he submits that even two accused did not make the statement. But it does not affect the compromise, because it was for the complainant to

say whether he had any objection to quash the FIR or not, since, his statement already stands recorded. In view of this, there should not be any impediment in allowing the parties to compromise the matter.

So, in view of the above circumstances the above said FIR stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR also stand quashed.
