Office has put up the case on account of the non-service of the private respondents.

On February 24, 2015 direction had been issued to take steps for giving complete addresses and depositing the process fee, so that service upon private respondents could be effected, failing which the case will be dealt with for want of prosecution.

On May 26, 2015 none had put in appearance and notice could not be issued to the unserved respondents No. 140, 142, 143, 147 to 149, 208 to 210, 230, 231, 237, 238, 244, 245, 256, 257, 261, 264, 266, 269, 275, 277, 283, 289, 291, 295 to 300, 303 and 304, whose selection is under challenge. Three weeks time was granted to do the needful within the stipulated period, failing which the petition was to be dismissed for want of prosecution.

Counsel for the petitioner had not been appearing for the last 3 occasions, neither any application for substituted service has been filed.

In such circumstances, the present writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
