Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.10 dated 16.1.2015 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station, Maqsudan, District Jalandhar.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioner.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 9.4.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. Thereafter even the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been presented to the court of competent jurisdiction. He concluded by submitting that the petitioner is entitled for concession of anticipatory bail.

The above-said factual aspect of the matter stated by the learned senior counsel for the petitioner could not be denied by the learned counsel for the State and rightly so, it being a matter of record.

In view of the above, the order dated 9.4.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
