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This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.204 dated 30.08.2014 registered under Sections 341/307/325/506/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is behind bars since 09.10.2014 and trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the

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case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.
