The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking directions to the official respondents to take appropriate measures to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who apprehend a threat to the same at the hands of private respondents.

Without making any observations on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of the assertions contained in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same at the initial stage itself by granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent no.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Sirsa as regards their grievance and apprehension and who in turn would be obligated to look into the same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
