Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.27 dated 28.1.2015 under Sections 323, 341, 452, 427, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 10.4.2015 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dharam Pal, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that the

custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 10.4.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
