Office has put up the case on account of the non-service of the private respondents.

On February 24, 2015 direction had been issued to take steps for giving complete address and depositing the process fee, so that service upon private respondent could be effected and with the condition that the case will be dealt with for want of prosecution.

On May 26, 2015 none had put in appearance and notice could not be issued to the unserved private respondents whose selection is under challenge. Three weeks time was granted to do the needful within the stipulated period, failing which the petition was ordered to be dismissed for want of prosecution.

Counsel for the petitioner has not been appearing for the last 3 occasions and neither any application for substituted service has been filed, for the service of the said respondents.

In such circumstances, the present writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
