This is the second application filed by the petitioner taking the advantage of the order dated 6.10.2014 passed by this Court enabling the petitioner to approach this Court again in case the trial is not concluded within a period of two months.

The petitioner is in custody from last two years in a case of recovery of commercial quantity of smack weighing 395 grams.

On the instructions of Head Constable Gurdyal Singh, State counsel informs that three witnesses out of sixteen stand already examined. Taking into consideration the aforesaid circumstances of the case, slow pace of the trial and the period of detention of two years having undergone by the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the prosecution agency fails to examine all the prosecution witnesses within three months from the next date of hearing, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction. Direction is also issued to the prosecution agency to conclude the trial by producing prosecution evidence within next three months.
