1. The present petition has been filed by petitioner Prabhdeep Singh under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 88 dated 12.06.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Phase-8, District S.A.S Nagar, Mohali.

2. As per the prosecution allegations, the present petitioner and his co-accused caused injuries with sharp

and blunt weapons to complainant Arun Rana. The petitioner was arrested in this case on 18.02.2015. Since then he is in custody. His application has been dismissed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, S.A.S Nagar, Mohali.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner pleads that the injury attributed to the present petitioner is simple in nature. The grievous injuries have been attributed to the non-applicants. He is in custody for the last more than three months.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel pleaded that various grievous injuries have been caused to the complainant Arun Rana. So, the petitioner does not deserves the concession of bail.

5. I have duly considered the aforesaid contentions.

6. This fact is not disputed that the injury attributed to the present petitioner on the head of the complainant Arun Rana has been found to be simple in nature. The grievous injuries have been attributed to the non-applicants. The petitioner is in custody for the last more than three months. The case is triable by the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class. There is no justification to further detained the petitioner in jail.

7. Thus without expression anything on the merits

of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and the petitioner Prabhdeep Singh Singh is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali
