Petitioners received earnest money of Rs. 10 lacs for a plot though the same had been mortgaged with Punjab National Bank.

The matter appears to have been compromised as is apparent from the affidavit of Ved Parkash respondent No.2 placed on record today.

The complainant having compromised the matter with the accused and the petitioners having discharged part of their liability, this petition is allowed. Interim order dated 03.04.2014 is hereby made absolute subject to condition as envisaged in under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. In case of terms of compromise being not fulfilled, it will be open to the complainant to approach this Court for cancellation of the bail.
