This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, vide FIR No.37 dated 4.3.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that dispute is primarily civil in nature. Petitioner is in custody since 4.3.2015. Investigating agency has not filed final report under section 173 Cr.P.C. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer.

Prayer has been opposed by learned State counsel. He, however, does not dispute the fact that petitioner incarcerated since 4.3.2015.

Heard.

Keeping in view the aforesaid contentions and the fact that case is triable by Magistrate and petitioner has been in custody since 4.3.2015, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by

detaining the petitioner any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court.
