Petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.58 dated 01.08.2012 under Sections 457, 380 IPC. Offence under Section 411 IPC was added later on. The FIR was got registered by the Headmaster of the school in respect of theft of two computers. Petitioner was once declared as proclaimed offender but under the orders of this Court, he surrendered on 24.02.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was implicated on the statement of Balvir Singh who appeared as PW-3 in this case and resiled therein. The witnesses has stated that he never made any statement to police, rather, he himself appeared before the Senior Superintendent of Police and brought this fact to his knowledge and thereafter Senior Superintendent of Police also ordered deletion of his name as witness.

Be that as it may, the petitioner is in custody since 24.02.2015.
Petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail
on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial
Court.
