FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.60 dated 17.4.2012 under Sections 420,467,468,471,120-B IPC registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District Mohali.

The allegations against the petitioner-Rakesh Kumar Bansal in this anticipatory bail application are that on 1.5.2006 the petitioner had made a fraudulent representation to the complainant-Rajesh Kumar now deceased being represented by his wife-Rajni that he was owner of a plot situated in Dera Bassi, District Mohali and on this fraudulent representation has received a sum of ₹6,22,200/- from the complainant. The averments of the learned counsel for the petitioner that parties have compromised has been conceded at bar by the learned

counsel for the complainant.

Though, the learned counsel for the State has sought to oppose the bail application, however, keeping in view that the petitioner has returned the entire amount and that it would suffice the purpose, thus, in the interest of justice, the present petition seeking anticipatory bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer and that he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
