Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in case bearing
FIR No.122 dated 15.12.2013 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC Police
Station Mallwawala, District Ferozepur.

Complainant has lodged this FIR against close relatives viz real
sister Amarjit Kaur, two daughters namely Mandeep Kaur and Surjit Kaur,
her son Manjit Singh and her two son-in-laws namely Sarwan Singh and
Harjit Singh. Harjit Singh is the present petitioner.

Learned counsel states that in respect of recovery of
Rs.14,23,000/- and amount of Rs.5 lacs, two civil suits for recovery are
pending before the Civil Courts. Other accused have already been granted
anticipatory bail by the Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurinder Singh
submits that challan has already been presented in this case. The alleged

accusation in terms of attempt to throw the complainant in river has not been accepted by the Investigating Agency. In the challan no complicity in terms thereof has been highlighted.

The trial being Magisterial in nature. Keeping in view filing of challan and pending two civil suits for recovery, this Court feels that petitioner can be granted regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur.
