Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case/FIR No.133 dated 12.12.2014 under Section 394 IPC (Section 397 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, Ropar (Annexure P1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in another FIR i.e. FIR No.136 dated 19.12.2014 under Section 399/402 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, the petitioner has been admitted to anticipatory bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar vide order dated 9.4.2015. Learned Additional Sessions Judge has observed that as per the copy of medical

report of the petitioner produced on record by learned counsel, there is a noting of doctor to the effect that two persons should stay with the patient, as he is unable to move without the help of at least two persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while relying upon the medical evidence states that the petitioner is ready to join investigation and get the recovery effected without prejudice to his rights.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, states that he has no objection to granting of anticipatory bail to the petitioner if he joins investigation and gets the recovery effected.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
