Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 253, dated 11.12.2014, under Sections 382 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Fazilka (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 21.03.2015 (Annexure P-2).

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise effected between the parties is voluntarily, without any duress, coercion or threat of any kind, rather the same has been effected in order to

keep peace and harmony and to restore cordial relations between the parties. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 253, dated 11.12.2014, under Sections 382 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Fazilka and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioners.
