The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.18 dated 19.02.2015, registered under Sections 308, 354, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, Distt. Rupnagar.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the alleged injury has been attributed to petitioner no.3 only, which has been declared simple in nature. He further states that the petitioners are in custody for over two months, the investigation stage is over and challan has been filed.

Learned State counsel informs that the injury is simple in nature. He further states that x-ray report has been received and no bony injury was seen in the x-ray.

The trial will take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
