This is second bail petition. The earlier bail petition has been decided on merits vide order dated 11.03.2014 passed in CRM No. M-2877 of 2014.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he along with others committed robbery of ₹15,000/-, Nokia phone and three suitcases and in that process, he caused injuries with knife.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Preet Singh, has stated at the bar that eight other cases of similar nature are pending against the petitioner.

The gravity of offence does not make out a case for grant of regular bail.

Dismissed.
