The petitioner pleads harassment at the hands of respondent No.3 She is facing a case under the NDPS Act. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not involved in any criminal activity but she is being forced to come to the police station time and again and harassed in this manner.

Without commenting on the veracity of the allegations set out in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction that in case the petitioner is required for some assistance by the police, they would take recourse to the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C.
