Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 323, dated 27.11.2013, under Sections 452, 323, 324 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 30.03.2015 (Annexure P-2).

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that matter has been compromised between the parties through the intervention of respectable and relatives, without any pressure or coercion and

compromise is genuine one. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 323, dated 27.11.2013, under Sections 452, 323, 324 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioners.
