Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondent No. 2 to get investigation of complaint moved by respondent No. 5 by a senior police officer of the rank of Superintendent of Police as respondent No. 5 has filed a false and frivolous complaint to rope in the petitioner in a false case relating to fraud and cheating.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that second enquiry in the complaint filed by respondent No. 5 is being held by respondent No. 4-SHO Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur as in the first enquiry, the petitioner was found innocent.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only, at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Gurveer Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4.

Let requisite number of copies of paper-book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

In view of the nature of order that is proposed to be passed, no reply is required to be filed by the respondents. The petitioner had already filed a representation dated 02.03.2015 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Batala in this regard.

The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Batala to look into the representation dated 02.03.2015 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps, if required, in accordance with law.
