Learned counsel for the respondents states that he has instructions to submit that petitioner No.1 stood dismissed from service while petitioner No.2 retired. If that be so then the effective cause espoused in the petition would hardly survive for adjudication.

Consequently, the writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but with liberty to the petitioners to move an appropriate application to revive the proceedings in case of their having any survival cause.
