Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take necessary steps on the representation dated 25.03.2015 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner and to protect her life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that after the registration of FIR No. 86 dated 16.03.2015 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 420/465/467/471/120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala, the petitioner is having threat to her life and liberty.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. SK Saini, AAG, Haryana

accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

Let requisite number of copies of paper-book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

In view of the nature of order that is proposed to be passed, no reply is required to be filed by the respondents. The petitioner had already filed a representation dated 25.03.2015 (Annexure P-2) before respondent No. 2-Deputy Commissioner of Police, Ambala in this regard.

The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Deputy Commissioner of Police, Ambala to look into the allegation of threat only to the life and liberty of the petitioner and take appropriate steps, if required, in accordance with law. The investigation of the FIR will, however, proceed in accordance with law.
