This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.44 dated 14.03.2015 under Sections 420/465/467 and 468 IPC at Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required. He is ready to co-operate with the investigating agency. Thus, petitioner be granted concession of pre-arrest bail.

Plea has been opposed by learned State counsel. FIR in the case was registered at the instance of Branch Manager of Central Cooperative Bank, Phase II, Mohali. The Bank officials while checking the application for loan moved by another employee i.e. C. Ravinder Singh, found that a pay slip had been annexed alongwith the application. It bore signatures and stamp of Harpal Singh, Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar. On the basis of suspicion Bank officials made enquiry from the office concerned.

Resultantly, enquiry was conducted by Deputy Superintendent of Police. He found that petitioner had forged the signatures of Sh. Harpal Singh, Superintendent of Police on pay slip of C. Ravinder Singh.

In view of nature of allegations, I am of the considered view that petitioner is not entitled to concession of pre-arrest bail.

Dismissed.
