Affidavits of both the petitioners have been handed over to the effect that they solemnised marriage on 08.04.2015 as per Sikh rites and this is the first marriage of petitioners. The same are taken on record. Registry to page mark the same.

Both the petitioners are present in person. They are stated to be major.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. A.S. Gill, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to supply three copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during the

course of day.

In view of the order which is proposed to be passed, no reply is required to be filed by the State.

In view of the limited prayer made in this petition without accepting the validity of marriage or the correctness of ages of the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to consider the representation dated 08.04.2015 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners and analyse threat perception and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

It is made clear that if a complaint for criminal offence or an FIR is pending, this order shall not cause any hindrance in those proceedings.
