This second petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure was filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case First Information Report No.67 dated 13.08.2014 under Section 302/307/34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Kanwan, District Pathankot.

The earlier petition filed by the petitioner vide CRM-M-34404-2014 was withdrawn vide order dated 24.02.2015. A similar petition filed by his co-accused Poonam vide CRM-M-34313-2014 was also got dismissed as withdrawn on the same date.

Learned State counsel pointed out that the petitioner and his co-accused Poonam have since been declared proclaimed offenders by the competent court.

In view of the matter, there being serious allegation against the petitioner and he having been declared proclaimed offender is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail and the instant petition filed by the petitioner is hereby dismissed.
