1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.90 dated 18.07.2014 registered under Sections 411, 414, 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 489-D IPC, Sections 15, 18, 21, 22, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, Sections 3, 34, 20 of the I.P. Act and Section 14-F Act, at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, District Amritsar City.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Harwinder Pal Singh states that the petitioner appeared before the investigating officer and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

However, she states that four cases are pending against the petitioner.

Be that as it may, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required in the present case. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 28.08.2015 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
