The matter was taken up for the first time on 15.1.2014. On that date and on the following dates, request was made for adjournment. Thereafter, written request was filed. Again on 11.3.2014, request was made for adjournment. Similar was the position on 25.3.2014. Thereafter, on 7.4.2014, no one appeared and the position remained the same on 2.5.2014. Thereafter, written request was filed on 11.7.2014 and the matter was adjourned. Again written request was filed.

On 23.9.2014, it was observed that there were many mistakes in the petition and it was mentioned that the petitioner may file correct copy.

However, nothing was done and again written request was filed. Thereafter, written request was filed on next two dates and today again, there is written request.

There is obviously no urgency in the matter because had the petitioner been aggrieved of anything, he would not have allowed the matter to remain pending without actual hearing for more than one year.

The petition is dismissed.
