The petitioner is in custody since 25.02.2014. He was arrested on the basis of disclosure statement made in FIR No. 23 dated 27.01.2014, under Sections 398, 401 of the Indian Penal Code and 25 of the Arms Act of Police Station Bawal. In the case in which he allegedly made a disclosure statement which led to recovery, he was acquitted on 04.11.2014.

State counsel submits that there are other cases pending against the petitioner and two of those cases were registered against him much prior to FIR No. 23 dated 27.01.2014 of Police Station Bawal. He was also acquitted in FIR No. 174 dated 24.08.2013 of Police Station Bawal. He was also acquitted in FIR No. 228 dated 17.09.2013 of Police Station Khol, District Rewari.

Out of total 21 witnesses, only five have been examined so far. The trial is not likely to conclude in the near future. Also, in view of the fact that in the case in which the petitioner allegedly made disclosure

statement which led to recovery, he having been acquitted, the petitioner is held entitled to the concession of bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
