The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.8 dated 30.01.2015, under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Jaurkian, District Mansa.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

The present petitioner is stated to be the driver of one of the vehicles which had brought oil to Thermal Plant, Banawali. Allegations are that the petitioner in connivance with the owner of the vehicle has mixed water with the oil and consequently, cheated the complainant.

Petitioner was arrested on 06.02.2015. Investigation in the present case is complete and learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Angrej Singh would apprise the Court that the challan has been presented on 04.04.2015.

The trial, as such, is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Keeping in view the length of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner and without making any observations on merits, petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
