This is the third petition filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.73, dated 04.05.2013, under Section 302 IPC (chargesheeted under Sections 304-B, 498A and 120-B IPC), registered at Police Station Sadar, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

In pursuant to the order dated 20.07.2015 passed by this Court, Mr. Darbari Lal, Addl. Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran has appeared and brought the lower court record showing that the order dated 29.01.2015 passed in CRM No.M-1039 of 2015 was never received by the said Court. Therefore, the compliance could not be made. The photocopy of the said order has been supplied to him. He has assured that the order dated 29.01.2015 shall be complied within letter and spirit.

As the trial is being expedited, therefore, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage.

The State is directed to produce the additional accused Gurbir Singh before the lower court on the next date of hearing.
