Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in Crime Case No.13/2014, dated 27.03.2014, under Sections 8, 20, 25 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Narcotic Control Bureau, Sector 25, Chandigarh.

This is second regular bail application. While dictating the contentions of the petitioner in earlier petition i.e. CRM M-1087 of 2015, on 03.03.2015, at that stage, learned counsel for the petitioner had withdrawn that petition.

Learned counsel for the respondent informs the Court that prosecution evidence is already over and the case is fixed for defence evidence for 30.05.2015. The trial is at the fag end.
