The petitioner is nominated as an accused in complaint case, lodged by respondent No. 2/Divisional Forest Officer, Gurgaon, for offences under Sections 32 and 33 of the Indian Forest Act. Since the petitioner had not surrendered himself before the Court, non-bailable warrants were issued to secure his presence, hence the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 06.05.2015, had permitted the petitioner to surrender before the Court and seek interim bail.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his client has already been granted bail and therefore, prays for withdrawal the present petition.
