Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Ajay Chopra in case FIR No.41 dated 10.03.2015 under Sections 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station City, Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

As per allegations, petitioner was the attesting witness to the agreement to sell executed by her sister Anita Dhir being power of attorney holder of their brother Arun Kumar, who is the owner of the three shops and were resiling from their part of the contract for getting the sale deed registered for the three shops, instead were offering two shops for sale.

At the time of hearing learned Counsel for the complainant states that the sale deed for three shops has since been executed and he has

no objection if the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner is confirmed since the parties have settled their matter.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sohan Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation. Still further in view of the stand of the complainant he has nothing more to say.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 15.04.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
