Reply by way of affidavit of Swapan Sharma, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fazilka on behalf of respondent no.1 to 3 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Petitioners have married without parental consent.

Notice was issued to the respondents – State of Punjab who have submitted their aforesaid reply stating as under:-

“1) That in compliance with orders dated 15.4.2015 facts mentioned in the petition as well as in the application no. 125-Local dated 14.4.2015 by Lakhvinder Singh son of Surain Singh resident of Dhani Miani Basti Tehsil Fazilka have been got verified through HC Gurdeep Singh of PS Sadar, Fazilka. In the application, Lakhvinder Singh father of petitioner Amandeep Kaur has alleged that petitioner no.2 Pamma has enticed his daughter and has established illicit relations with her. On the intervening night 12-13/4.2015 he along with his family members were under influence of sleeping tablets. The petitioners have taken away gold ornaments weighing about 7/8 tolas and also cash amount of Rs.15000/- from his home. These facts were also verified and as per report of HC

Gurdeep Singh the facts mentioned in the application about gold ornaments and cash amount have been found false and during enquiry vide DDR no.12 dated 14.4.2015 of PS Sadar, Fazilka, HC Gurdeep Singh went to Police Post, Sector 61, Chandigarh and has joined SI Ram Rattan Sharma with the proceedings who has revealed that the petitioners Amandeep Kaur and Paramjeet Singh are majors and they have solemnized marriage who have also sought protection from the parents of Amandeep Kaur petitioner. During enquiry, the date of birth of petitioner Amandeep Kaur has been verified as per school record of Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School, Fazilka and the date of birth of Amandeep Kaur is 4.1.1996 who herself had appeared and suffered statement that she has performed marriage with Paramjeet Singh petitioner on 12-13/4/2015 at Gurdwara Shri Gurunanak Dev Ji Phase VI Mohali and are living as husband and wife and they have no complaint from local police. The said statement is also endorsed by Paramjeet Singh petitioner. The report of HC Gurdeep Singh is also attested by SHO PS Sadar, Fazilka and being so the application of Lakhvinder Singh respondent no.4 has been filed. Local police is duty bound to protect the life and liberty of each and every citizen of India.”

In view of the aforesaid reply filed by the respondents - State of Punjab, instant petition is disposed of .
