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**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)**

This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 08 dated 02.02.2015 under Sections 307/341/324/323/506/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Jodhan, District Ludhiana Rural.

On 22.4.2015, the following order was passed by this Court.

*“Learned senior counsel, at the very outset, makes a statement that he is not pressing the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking the concession of pre-arrest bail qua petitioner no.1 namely Jagjit Singh son of Jangir Singh.*

*Accordingly, the instant petition qua petitioner no.1 stands dismissed.*

*It has been argued that in so far as petitioners no.2 and 3 are concerned, the allegations are of being armed with base ball and petitioner no.2 namely Hardeep Singh having given a base ball blow on the left arm of complainant Hardeep Singh and petitioner no.3 namely Mandeep Singh @ Amandeep Singh having given a base ball blow and which landed on the left leg of the father of the complainant namely Sukhdev Singh. It is further contended that it was non-applicant namely Karamjit Singh, who had allegedly given the gandasi blow on the head of father of complainant and which has attracted offence under Section 307 I.P.C.*

*List on 22.5.2015.*

*In the meantime, petitioners no.2 and 3 are directed to join investigation and to appear before the I.O on 30.4.2015.*

*In the event of arrest, petitioners no.2 and 3 shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and they shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”*

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Hardeep Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

This Court has also been informed that co-accused Jagjit Singh son of Jangir Singh as also Karamjit Singh have since surrendered.

That apart the observations contained in the order dated 22.4.2015 passed by this Court have not been rebutted.

Accordingly, petition is allowed. Order dated 22.04.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
