The instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C is disposed of at the initial stage itself in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent no.3 i.e. S.S.P., S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) with regard to the alleged apprehension that has been voiced of being sought to be implicated in certain false proceedings and repeated raids that have been conducted on the premises of the petitioners to inquire about the whereabouts of Gurjant Singh younger son of petitioners no.1 and 2 and who as per counsel is a drug addict and has been disowned by his parents. Respondent no.3 i.e. S.S.P., S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) in turn would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.
