LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner prays for anticipatory bail in FIR No. 14 dated 17.01.2014 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh.

It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this FIR, which is a counterblast to FIR No. 200 dated 20.06.2013, the details of which are mentioned in para 2 of the petition, the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to interim order of this Court.

Learned counsel for UT, Chandigarh, on instructions from Sub Inspector Jai Bhagwan affirms that the petitioner has indeed joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation. There are no allegations on behalf of the State that petitioner is likely to abscond or that he is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

In view of above, order dated 01.05.2014 is made absolute without commenting on the merits of the case.

The present petition is, accordingly, allowed.
