Through the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short "Cr.P.C."), the petitioner prays for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 6 to provide appropriate security to him and his family members.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that after the murder of his brother the petitioner was having security from the State till last year but the security was abruptly withdrawn and now he again fears danger to his life. He has given representations to the Superintendent of Police, which have not been decided till date. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to bear the expenses if security is provided to him.

3. In view of the above, respondent no.4 Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot is directed to look into the representations given by the petitioner and decide the same at the earliest.

Disposed of accordingly.
