JASPAL SINGH, J.

The present petition has been preferred by Ashok Kumar-
petitioner, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for
grant of pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case
bearing FIR No. 17, dated 07.03.2015, under Sections 498-A, 354
and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Talwara Mushraferi,
District Hoshiarpur.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in compliance
of order dated April 17, 2015 passed by a coordinate Bench of this
Court, petitioner has already joined the investigation and is no more

required for further investigation.

So, taking into consideration all these aspects of the case, order dated April 17, 2015, is made absolute, subject to the following conditions, as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C:

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.*
