The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.21 dated 28.02.2015, under Sections 323/324/326/34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

Having argued the matter at some length, counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

He further submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender and if thereafter, a petition seeking regular bail under Section 439 C.P.C. is filed, the same be directed to be decided expeditiously.

Prayer is allowed. Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner duly surrenders and thereafter files an application seeking benefit of regular bail, the trial Court would make every endeavor to expedite the same.
