This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.263 dated 20.12.2008 registered under Sections 498-A/506 and 406 IPC at Police Station Model Town, Hoshiarpur, on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated September 25, 2014, this court had directed the trial court to record statement of the parties to ascertain whether compromise was genuine and voluntary. A report has been received relevant para whereof reads as under:-

“Thereafter, notice to complainant again issued for 12.11.2014 and on 12.11.2014 statement of petitioners/accused Vijay Kumar and Roshan Lal recorded and notice to complainant again issued for 19.11.2014. On 19.11.2014 complainant-Kanchan Dogra and refused to make any statement. However, her signatures were obtained on the interim sheet. Original copies of statements of the petitioners/accused and copy of interim sheet on which signatures of complainant

Kanchan Dogra obtained are also enclosed herewith.”

In view of above, no case for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise is made out.
